The Word of the Laird...

Today and for the next four Sundays we will be reading the section of Matthew's Gospel that includes Jesus' activity. The death of John the Baptist at Herod's hands is recounted and leads into today's miracle of the first multiplication of loaves and fish (Mt. 14:13-21). Matthew also has a second episode of multiplied loaves and fish. (Mt. 15:32-39). In the first episode 5,000 men are fed; in the second 4,000. In both instances it is mentioned that the number did not include women and children. The second episode is not in the lectionary's cycle of readings.

Then there are cures and questions that Jesus answers. He predicts his suffering and death, but is also transfigured in front of Peter, James and John.

One of the significant parts of Jesus' ministry is that He is an itinerant rabbi. Most rabbis would settle into a synagogue or find some type of stable venue in which they would gather their followers. But Jesus travels about bringing the message to all who would hear him, instead of those who would seek him out. This is what sets his ministry apart from those of his contemporaries.

Also, the miracles of the loaves and fish form a type of prelude to the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper.

As we hear these stories, we might imagine ourselves present and how would we have reacted to these events? How might we better respond to them in our day?


