The Word of the Laird...

Today's first reading from Jeremiah, "You duped me, Lord, and I let myself be duped..." can sometimes reflect how we all feel. We might have thought we were getting into one thing and then it turns out quite different from what we expected. Jeremiah didn't get the response from the people to whom he delivered his message, or rather, God's message, that he expected. At one point he ends up being left in a cistern, so unpopular were his words.

Today's Gospel really has to be read along with last Sunday's Gospel. Last Sunday Jesus blessed Peter. But once Peter hears about the suffering that Jesus anticipated, he gets called "Satan." The two interchanges are almost parallel in the way in which Matthew presents them.

I suppose I could reflect on some of these things in my own experience. I would never have thought that I would be celebrating Easter Sunday Mass in a church that was nearly empty. I didn't anticipate the changes that would occur on our staff.

With all of these things, it becomes an opportunity to see how God's grace might be working at a deeper level than we may have been able to anticipate.

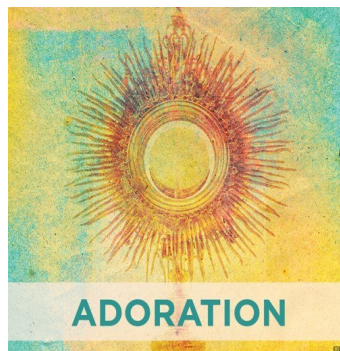

Sacrament of Reconciliation:

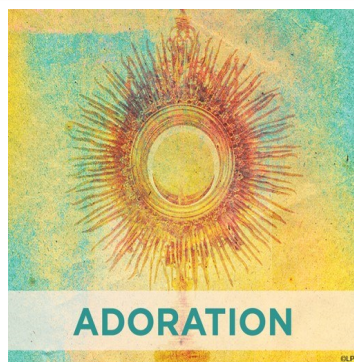
Saturdays from 3:30 to 4:00 pm at St. Matthew or call either parish office for an appointment.
