With the advancement of the COVID-19 virus back in March, we had to put non-essential employees on unemployment. These included Bob Cope (Administrative Assistant), Jen Hughes (Faith Formation), Erin Ebersold (Youth Ministry) and Cris Wensel (Pastoral Associate). While we have not gotten a positive notice from the diocese about putting people back on the payroll, we did take a look at what changes the current situation mean for our Faith Community.

Bob Cope informed us that he had accepted a full time position elsewhere. His job duties have been absorbed by the Business Manager and the Administrative Assistants. I wish him the best in his new position. I had been planning to wait until the beginning of August to talk with Jen and Erin about what activities would be consistent with the school situation for this coming year. Jen let us know that she had been looking at other possibilities and had accepted a position elsewhere. I wish her the best in her new position. Erin informed us that she would not be continuing with Youth Ministry to spend more time with her family. I thank Erin for her many years of service to our Faith Community. She has played an active role in over 300 children's lives as they prepared for the sacrament of Confirmation, for her many years as Youth Minister and sharing the experience of NCYC with our youth. She will be greatly missed.

We took a look at it and felt that, with the number of young people in Faith Formation and Youth Ministry, we could reasonably combine the two jobs into one position. We drew up a job description and placed it with the diocese and have already received two applicants whom we will try to interview shortly.






