## *The Word of the Laird...*

The Gospels for these remaining Sundays in Ordinary Time are taken from Chapters 22, 23 and 25 of Matthew's Gospel. As I mentioned in last Sunday's homily, these are all taking place following Jesus' entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. There is a certain growth in the tensions that can be observed through the episodes recounted. Tensions grow between Jesus and a variety of groups: the priests, the Pharisees, the Sadducees. Eventually the Romans are also brought into it.

In Chapter 23 we find Jesus uttering a series of woes against the Scribes and Pharisees, matching the blessings uttered in Chapter 5 at the beginning of the Sermon on the Mount. Also in these Chapters are parables about being ready for the kingdom of God. To some extent, Matthew is also reflecting the developments that have taken place in the community for which he is writing this Gospel, close to the year 70.

Matthew concludes Jesus' public ministry with encouragement for his community to be faithful and consistent in doing good for others, as we are encouraged to do even today.

## Prayer for Spiritual Communion

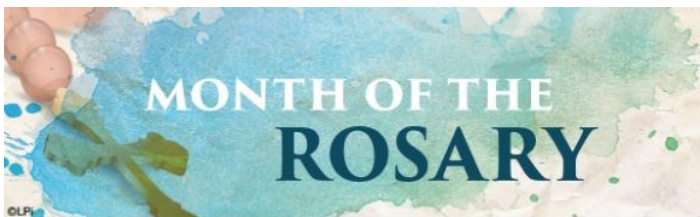
